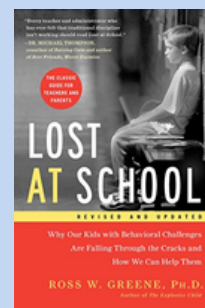


Lost at School: Why Our Kids with Behavioral Challenges are Falling Through the Cracks and How We Can Help Them
